Just a reminder about the upcoming changes to the PVG system, which will require you to provide an email address and ensure that your details are up to date. See below for an extract from the information they provided, with instructions on how to provide any update required:

“From 1 April 2026, individuals who join the Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) scheme will automatically be part of the five-year PVG scheme membership.

Many PVG scheme members will not need to do anything ahead of the move to the five-year scheme.

If you are a PVG scheme member who has not recently applied for PVG (for example, you haven’t applied

since PVG moved online in 2021), it's important that you tell us your current email address. We need this so that we can get in touch with you easily in the future to tell you when you are moving to the five-year scheme and how to create your online account.

Please email dsupdate@disclosurescotland.gov.scot with the subject header 'Email address update', your:

- name
- date of birth
- PVG scheme number
- current email address"

(If you need a note of your PVG scheme number or your date of application please email the church office.)
