All those who are involved in ministries with children and young people in Hebron are required to attend the **Hebron Safeguarding Refresher** once every two years. The next one will be on Sunday at 9.30am in the Conference Room before the morning service. Please add your name in the Safeguarding Training sign up link to say you are coming. (If you didn't come in March 2025 – which was the first time we ran it on a Sunday before the service – you are expected this time!)
