The Sunday School Prize Giving will be taking place in the Morning Service on 21st June.

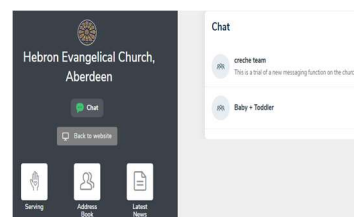

The Hebron App has a new feature which allows us to send messages within serving teams. This will be useful because often emails can be missed or end up in junk mail (the irony of telling you this by email is not lost on us!) It is in a trial stage at the moment and feedback will be very useful to help us know how effective it is, in terms of receiving notifications and helpful messages. At the moment, the only group who has received a message is the creche team so they should see a green speech bubble in the top right of the app home page now, which can be clicked on to read and reply to messages. (Grey section on the left if looking on a laptop screen) To receive notifications when a new message is sent in the app you will need to "allow" them the next time you open



the app or you can turn them on in your own phone settings (or just delete the app and reinstall it!)

If you don't yet have the app, you can download it from www.hebronaberdeen.org.uk/hubb and we recommend it as worthwhile - even though life can be way too full of apps – because it's a really easy way to check your rotas, find an address, catch up on sermons and sign up for events.
