The Hebron Church App is continuing to develop and is a really useful tool for anyone in the church to use. It simplifies access to any rotas you are on, as well as being a quick way to catch up on sermons. (And once you've got it installed on your phone it keeps you logged in for ages so less password hassles!)

New in the last month or so is the Chat function which is super helpful for everyone who is on a rota. Any changes or swaps being made can be arranged in the chat without having to scroll through emails to find the latest discussion – so much easier...

We are very keen to have as many as possible get used to using it over the summer so that rotas can run more smoothly when we've got all of them back in place after the break. It will also help us with our GDPR requirements and save everyone from handing out contact details to multiple groups on email and whatsapp. Please do have a look at downloading it soon, look around it and get used to where to find things – it's pretty easy so won't take you long!

New this week: the app now has a way to view any messages sent to you from the church, such as the weekly newsletter and rota reminders, so if you sometimes miss them coming in on email, you can find them in your Inbox on the app. Click here now to get started (remember to allow notifications): www.hebronaberdeen.org.uk/hubb
