On Sunday:

11am – Holiday Club Service at Bon Accord Free Church, Rosemount Viaduct. *no morning service in Hebron*

Remember that on Sunday morning, we will be holding a joint service with the other churches involved in the Holiday Club week. This year it will be held in Bon Accord Free Church round the corner on Rosemount Viaduct at 11am. All will be warmly welcomed there to hear all about the work of the week and to give thanks together.

Do give thanks for the summer Holiday Club and Stay & Play sessions which took place last week, for the volunteers who made it possible and for all the children and families who came along and heard the good news about King Jesus – there were 80 children in the kids club over the course of the week and an average of 15 little ones each day at the Stay and Play. Thank you for your prayers as we prepared and during the week, and thank you for all the donations of snack supplies and home baking which kept everyone going each day!
